

FAQ – Good to know

Do I have to register or is it possible to drop in?

Your registration helps us to reserve the place (sleeping tents, camping site, tents for meals etc) and to organise the meals properly. However it is also possible to drop in but registration is preferred. Plus - when you are registered you do not have to wait that long at the welcome point.

Where can I ask when I want to volunteer?

Volunteers can contact info@jugend2000.org . It is also possible to volunteer without having contacted Y2k beforehand, just mention it at the welcome point.

What to do if I don't have a custodian?

If you are under 16 you need to bring a custodian with you. If you can't find a person who is over 18, please contact us and we will assign a custodian to you. In any case you have to bring the parents agreement (you'll find it under downloads on this website in the registration area).

I don't want to sleep in a tent. Are there any other possibilities?

On the camp site accommodation is only possible in your own tent or in the huge sleeping tents. Mobile homes or caravans can be parked at one's own risk on the parking lot. However, electrical power supply is not possible. In the surrounding of Pfaffenhofen there are pensions, spare beds, hostels and hotels. Accommodation out of the site has to be looked for and booked at one's own account. A list of accommodations is to be found under downloads.

I am a priest/religious. What do I have to consider?

Please do remark that you are a priest/religious in the registration form. Our staff in charge of the priests/religious will contact you. We would very much appreciate if you could bring a group of young people from your parish/area! Flyer and posters are available at flyer@prayerfestival.org. For priests: Please bear in mind to bring alba, stole and your celebret.

How much does it cost?

The Prayer Festival is donation based. Please provide for a donation you want and you are able to give. The recommended value for one participant is 20€ per day/ 80€ for the five-day stay.

We want to come as a group, do we have to consider anything?

Every participant has to register himself in order to receive a personal registration code. Therefore a group registration is not possible!

Keep in mind, that all underaged participants need to bring the parents agreement (you'll find it under downloads on this website in the registration area). Participants under 16 need to bring a custodian with them.

I am under 18 – where can I find the parents agreement?

You will find the parent's agreement under downloads in the registration area. We kindly ask you to bring the signed agreement with you and to hand it out at the reception desk.
